Day1 assignment, August 12, 2021

Before attempting this assignment, be sure to have logged in to repl. If you missed class, here is the short version: on your Chromebook, log in to your school Google account. Then open a new tab and visit https://replit.com/. Create a new Java repl. Then modify the code as requested below.

Your task for today: using 5 lines of code print something similar to the following (you must include your name, and you must print at least two lines).

```
Hello. My name is <your name>. Nice to meet you. This is going to be a great year!
```

Only 2 of your lines of code can be println, the other 3 must be print calls.

Here's an example of what I'm talking about, but with a different message:

This code:

```
System.out.print("I");
System.out.print(" had a great su");
System.out.println("mmer.");
System.out.print("I hope you ");
System.out.println("did too!");
```

prints this:

```
I had a great summer. I hope you did too!
```

I'm asking you to do the text up above ("Hello. My name is ...") but this example shows you the sort of thing I want you to do.

Run your project as many times as you want, and make adjustments if it's not working before you turn it in. Ask for help if you're stuck.

To turn in your project, click the Invite button in Repl, get a join link, and turn the link in on the Google Classroom. If you are not clear how to do this, watch the attached video.
