Mother's Day Gift 2022

All Make 1 and Make 2 students Inkscape/.stl /electronic file due Monday 4/25/22 Final project completed by Thursday 4/28 - Friday 4/29

Mother's Day is coming up (Sunday May 9). I am asking everyone to make something nice using our Project Make tools for their mother (or another significant adult in their lives) by Wednesday Friday 4/29/22. The project can use a 3D printer, the laser cutter, the vinyl cutter, or CNC machine, construction paper, a combination of tools and materials, or something else entirely. I will provide wood, vinyl, acrylic, cardboard, etc. at no charge in most cases. If you want to try glass etching (using a vinyl sticker on glass with acid to etch a design onto glass) you will need to find your own glass item (bottle, jar, vase, etc.).

Like our Valentine's Day project from February, this project must show significant effort on your part. Making a simple laser burn on a piece of wood, or a CNC block or vinyl sticker that says "I heart mom" is not significant effort. Making a multi-part wooden laser cut creation is more like what I'm looking for, as would be a complex 3D model that is printable, something that you know makes your mother's life better that you can make, a beautiful hand painted paper card, a complex and beautiful Inkscape design, something you knit or otherwise made, or a 5 color vinyl sticker that required node editing and creative effort.

Someone should say "wow" when they see your finished product.

Requirements:

- The object is an appropriate gift of appreciation to your mother (or another important adult in your life, your choice.)
- The object is something that you have created yourself. You can incorporate art or graphics from the Internet, but other people's creations cannot be the majority of your design.
- The object shows significant effort on your part. If you wonder what I mean by this, come chat with me.
- I will provide a reasonable amount of wood, vinyl or acrylic for you to use at no charge. Larger creations might require money or that you provide your own materials.
- The object is awesome (meaning, it makes people say "wow!")

There are two parts to getting full credit for this assignment:

1) Turn in your design file on the Google classroom (.stl or Inkscape file, etc.) by Monday 4/25/22, and

2) Show me your completed creation by the end of class Thursday 4/28 - Friday 4/29.
