

WC Creature

Due: 4th period: Thursday 9/30
5th period: Friday 10/1

Today you will make an Inkscape document containing a W, a C, and the silhouette of a creature. Think of this as a possible West County High School mascot/logo/design.

Requirements:

Your design contains a capital W. (Choose whatever font you want.)

Your design may or may not contain a capital C, it's your choice.

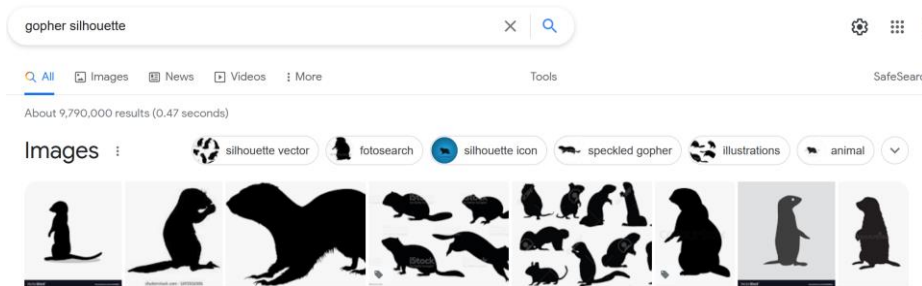
Your design contains a silhouette of a creature (not a human).

The elements are all connected, union-ed or differenced in Inkscape to be a single unit/path.

Your design looks good and is interesting and fun, plus it's neat and clean and well-put together.

You can find cool silhouette images on Google by searching for the creature you're interested in with the word "silhouette" and choosing the Images tab in the results.

For example, I searched for "gopher silhouette" and got the following:



You cannot use gopher as your animal, sorry. I have dibs on that.

When done, turn off all stroke, turn on fill, and set the color to whatever color you want (except for white, since that would make your creation invisible.)

Keep Opacity set to 100% (never change that, it should be 100% for all Inkscape projects all year.) Also keep the A: value at 255. In other words, feel free to change the R, G, and B settings to whatever you want, but leave the A and Opacity as shown in this image here.

When you are done, save your project as your name and then "WC" and turn the Inkscape file in on the Google Classroom.
