4th and 6th: Due Thursday, November 18, 2021 3rd, 5th, 7th: Due Friday, November 19, 2021

In the spirit of Thanksgiving I am asking you to write a thank you note to someone. You could write a friend, a family member, a teacher, or someone else in your life you want to thank for something.

You can write a note on paper, you can write an email, or you can write a note in a Google Doc. If you write it on paper, come by and show it to me (I won't read it, I just want to see that you did it). If you write an email, please copy your note before clicking Send and paste it into a Google Doc and turn that in. If you write the note in a Google Doc to begin with, simply turn that Doc in. If you do this at home before Friday midnight, take a photo of what you did and turn that in.

The note should be written with proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation, and should be authentic. Write something that you would actually give to the person. I encourage you to follow through and give the note; people love being appreciated.

Your note should be at least three sentences long and should start and end like a real letter or note. Be specific about what you are thanking the person for.

When done, turn it in as noted above.
