

Thank you note

3rd, 5th, 7th: Due Friday, November 20, 2020 by 5pm

In the spirit of Thanksgiving I am asking you to write a thank you note to someone. You could write a friend, a family member, a teacher, or someone else in your life you want to thank for something.

You can write a note on paper, you can write an email, or you can write a note in a Google Doc. If you write it on paper, please take a photo of the note and turn the photo in on the Google Classroom. If you write an email, please copy your note before clicking Send and paste it into a Google Doc and turn that in. If you write the note in a Google Doc to begin with, simply turn that Doc in.

The note should be written with proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation, and should be authentic. Write something that you would actually give to the person. Your note should be at least three sentences long and should start and end like a real letter or note. Be specific about what you are thanking the person for.

When done, turn it in as noted above. I encourage you to actually send/deliver the note; people appreciate being appreciated.
