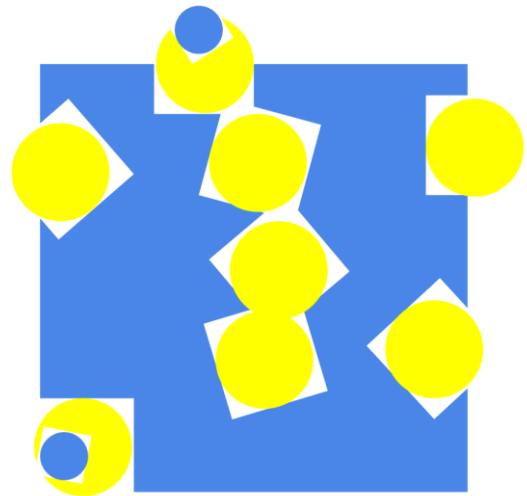
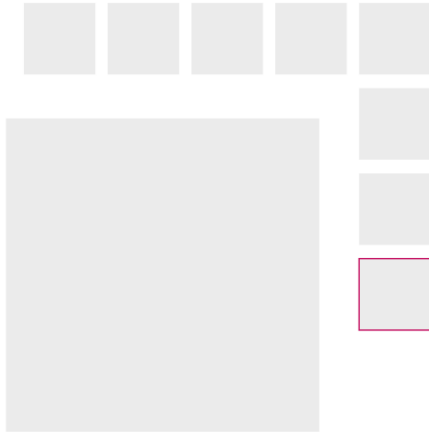


Gravit Take-away creation
Project Make/Make 2

In Gravit, create something like this to the right.



Start with a big square. Then make a small square.
Make 8 copies of the small square:



Then, one at a time, drag over a small square so that it is overlapping the big square. Select them both, then do the "Create compound shape: Subtract" operation to take a piece of the big square away. Repeat this seven more times until you've nibbled 8 small squares' worth of parts from the big square, as shown to the right. Rotate some of the small squares before you subtract them.



Then, make a circle that will fit inside of one of the small squares. Make 7 more copies of the circle so you have 8 circles. Put one circle "inside" of each small square. See my samples here on this page.

Make a new small square (smaller than the circles) and use it to take a bite out of one of the small circles. Then, make a new smaller circle and put it inside. On my final design this is the very top circle. Here is a close-up of what I'm talking about:



Just do this once. Then make all the colors fun (nothing should be the default gray). Turn in a share link when you are done.
