1. Copy this list from the PDF and paste it into your program. Use the list to print an interesting pattern that uses `.center()` `.rjust()` and or `.ljust()` in a way that you have not printed these things before.

```
data = [7,10,13,12,9,6,8,11,14]
```

2. Print the numbers 1 through 50 in 8 columns with a tab between each column.

3. Ask the user to enter a number from 3 to 7 inclusive. Use a try/except structure. Say "Too low" if the user enters a number less than 3, say "Too high" if the user enters a number greater than 7, and say "Not a number" if the user does not enter a number.

4. Print a square of stars with the width of the user's number from #3. In other words, if the user enters a 5, print this:
