## Project Make Mr. Hays, 2024

- 1. Always wear eye protection.
- 2. Use a soldering stand and place iron in stand when in use; never place iron on work table.
- 3. Keep the hot end safely away from power cords and people. Be aware of your surroundings. Do not mess around.
- 4. Do not flick solder. Use a damp sponge or the wire mesh to clean the tip.
- 5. Keep flammable items clear of hot iron and work area.
- 6. Do NOT touch the hot tip.
- 7. When you can, use "helping hands" clamps to hold work.
- 8. Never solder a "live" circuit (one that is connected to power).
- 9. Use fume extractor if doing extensive work.
- 10. Give your soldered surface a minute to cool down before you touch it.
- 11. Turn off and unplug unit when not in use. Never leave unattended.
- 12. Stay focused. Do not mess around!
