

Knife safety:

The following are some basic safety guidelines for working with our box-cutter knives in Project Make.

Please read these over and let me know if you have any questions.

Then, when done, do the assignment below.

- Never cut towards your own or someone else's body.
- Use a cutting board
- Sheathe the knife and put it away when done
- Use the right tool for the job (don't try to use a tiny knife to cut a big piece of wood for example.)
- Don't mess around with knives.
- Don't extrude too much of the blade, these are box cutters, not hunting knives.
- If a knife is broken, give it to Mr. Hays.
- Put knife back where you got it when you are done.

Assignment:

Find a partner or work alone. Since this is a make-up (most people were present the other day when we did this in class, you may have to work alone)

Using a knife, cutting board, and one piece of 9 by 18 cardboard, make a piece of furniture. It must have at least 5 separate pieces that hold together without tape or glue.

When done, show it to me, then clean up your workspace.
