

Talent Sign

Due: Monday 9/25/23

Check out this sign, which is for a skate shop in Burlington, Vermont:



I liked the way all the letters of the word "TALENT" were attached along the top like that.

Your task today: create an interesting sign that does the same thing, either vertically or horizontally, with some text. The text must be at least 5 letters, all caps, and could be your name (first or last or both), a pretend company name, an inspiring message, or something else that you feel like creating that does this.

All of the letters must be joined to a bar that cuts across them all, whether it's vertical or horizontal. To see if you're doing things correctly, turn off all Fill and turn the stroke to .5 pixels or so, so it's easy to see what's happening. You cannot use the word TALENT in your sign.

Here are some examples of good and bad creations:

Good: (except you can't do the word TALENT):

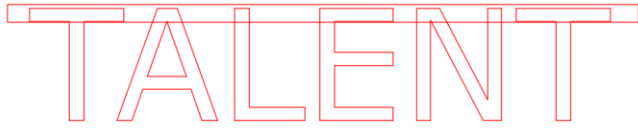


Bad: (bar is too thin, it does not "contain" the tops of the letters completely):

Bad: (The artist did not do Path>Union to combine the parts, see first good example for what a good one should look like):



Bad: (small letters are not what I'm asking for; your text should be all caps)



Bad: (you have to turn off the fill so that I can see what is happening inside the letters, see top one from this page where they were not unioned properly):



When you're done, make sure the Fill is all off. Set the stroke to our usual 255 red at .1 mm. Save as to the Desktop, name your file with your name in it and "sign". Turn the file in on the Google Classroom. I look forward to seeing your creations.
