How to make something write-up Project Make and Make 2 First draft due Monday/Tuesday 11/6 – 11/7 Final version due Wednesday/Thursday 11/8 – 11/9

For this assignment you will consider something that you have recently made (at home, at work, in class, etc) and then write up a document that explains to someone unfamiliar with the task how to get it done.

What can you write up? Just about anything, as long as it is something you have actually made, that it has 5 or more steps, is school appropriate, and can be documented thoughtfully and thoroughly. Examples: a doghouse, a chicken coop, a robotic Halloween prop, a meal, a cake, cookies, a two color vinyl sticker, a 3D printed keychain, a knitted sweater... just about anything.

Requirements:

To get full credit, your document will include the following:

- It must be about something that you personally have made
- A short introduction describing the project you are about to write up
- A list of materials needed
- Step by step instructions with numbers, detailing the process for making your thing
- Five or more instructions for getting the job done
- One or more photos, showing part of the process, and/or the final product
- Be clear and neat and be written with proper grammar and spelling

Write up your project in a Google Doc and turn in a first draft and then final version by these dates:

First draft: document should be titled with your name, the project name, and the word "draft". For example, "Hays, chicken coop, draft" would work.

First draft due today.

Final version: I recommend making a copy of the first draft, and renaming it while you do your final edits. The final version should have your name and the project name in the title without the word "draft" or "Copy of". Try to present this clearly and professionally. Put your best foot forward.

Final version due on separate (to be posted that day) Google Classroom assignment, Wednesday/Thursday this week.
