Thank you note
Due by the end of class today

In the spirit of Thanksgiving I am asking you to write a thank you note to someone. You could write a friend, a family member, a teacher, or someone else in your life you want to thank for something.

You can write a note on paper, you can write an email, or you can write a note in a Google Doc. If you write it on paper, come by and show it to me (I won't read it, I just want to see that you did it). If you write an email, please copy your note before clicking Send and paste it into a Google Doc and turn that in. If you write the note in a Google Doc to begin with, simply turn that Doc in.

The note should be written with proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation, and should be authentic. Write something that you would actually give to the person. I encourage you to follow through and give the note; people love being appreciated.

Your note should be at least three sentences long and should be specific about what you are thanking the person for. Start and end the note like a real letter. (For example, "Dear mom:" and "Thanks, Frankie").

When done, turn it in (or show me) as noted above.
